Once they share the message, they will share our goal, and then ask to pledge one of their hands for \$1.00 a hand. The person pledging, will then write his/her name/business on the hand along with the child's name. (Checks can be made to Quentin Elementary Hands Project). Once your child has all ten hands pledged, please return the hands and the money in an envelope with your child's name and teacher. The money will be used to purchase your child's hand shirt and the hand will be displayed in Quentin for people to see!

Students, who have all ten hands turned in with their \$10 by Monday February 5th, will receive ten official Hands Tickets (Positive Behavior Ticket).
